B) HORSES / PONIES

The lodging of the competing horses will be taken care by the Organizing Committee, from 12,00 p.m. of the 16-05-2007 until 12,00 p.m. of the 21-05-2007.

All costs referring to the foreign riders' horses will be paid by the Organizing Committee at an average of 0,25 € by kilometre per truck (one per invited rider), independently of the number of grooms and horses each brings, from the border to Club de Campo Villa de Madrid and back.

Each competing horse will be allowed daily, from the 16-05-2007 until the 20-05-2007, to 6 kilos of oats, 6 kilos of hay and 25 kilos of straw or wood shavings per day, or its equivalent in money. It must be demanded each day before 09,00 a.m. Any supplement of the horses' diet will be at the rider's expense.

If horses should have to prolong their stay due to any circumstances after 20-05-2007, all expenses that arise are at rider's or owner's charge.

VERY IMPORTANT: We would like to inform all the riders that the Organizing Committee can not offer additional boxes at the facilities, so horses that are not competing at the CSI could not be accept in any case.

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT
FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. **The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**
